TERMS & CONDITIONS

Payment

- 1. Payment of sponsorship/trade display must be made in full within 14 days of confirmation. If full payment is not received within 14 days of confirmation, the application may be considered canceled, and sponsorship/trade display may be reassigned.
- 2. All prices are in NZD and are exclusive of GST.

Cancellation and withdrawal

- 1. You must notify the Nutrition Society of New Zealand Conference Organising Committee in writing as soon as possible if you wish to cancel either your sponsorship or trade display.
- 2. If withdrawal should occur within 30 days of the conference, the organisers reserve the right to charge up to 50% of applicable fees.

Approval of sponsorship applications

1. Approval of sponsorship applications will be at the discretion of the Conference Organising Committee based on the NSNZ sponsorship guidelines. All companies are required to be complying with all food regulations under the Food Act 2014, specifically including composition and labeling/promotion regulations.

Assigning trade displays

1. All trade display spaces will be assigned by the Conference Organising Committee. This is so that the best interests of the conference delegates, other exhibitors, and the conference venue are met.
